Chairman McBride called the meeting to order at 9:38 a.m. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Chairman McBride asked if there were any revisions for the agenda. None were indicated.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

#### Chairman McBride continued with New Business:

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve Resolution 2019-40 to amend the IRC Section 125 Flexible Benefits Plan to allow a participant to redirect on a non-tax basis, a portion of the gross compensation for reimbursement of health expenses to the extent that such expenses do not exceed \$2,750.00 per plan year and allow the Chairman to sign. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve an agreement between Logan County and Cervi Championship Rodeo Company for the production, management and stock contract supply for the 2020 Logan County PRCA Rodeo and subsequent years to 2024. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Township 12 North, Range 55 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado, and Section 29, Township 12 North, Range 54 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado, and Lots One (1), Two (2), and the South Half (S½) Section 23, Township 12 North, Range 50 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado, and the West Half (W½) Section 28, Township 12 North, Range 49 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado, and Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4), and the South Half of the South Half (S½S½) of Section 23, Township 12 North, Range 49 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado. Rob Quint with the Logan County Planning and Zoning office explained the application. There being no further comment, Chairman McBride closed the public hearing.

Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve Resolution 2019-42 approving the vacation of a Subdivision Exemption plat previously approved for Thomas J. Huss and Brenda S. Huss on December 4, 2018 and recorded at Book 1030, Page 712. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve Resolution 2019-43 approving a Subdivision Exemption on behalf of Thomas J. Huss and Brenda S. Huss to create a 4.22-acre parcel from a 155-acre parcel in an Agricultural Zone located in the Northeast Quarter (NE1/4) of Section 23, Township 10 North, Range 51 West of the Sixth Principal Meridian, Logan County, Colorado. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

Commissioner Bauder moved to approve an agreement between Logan County and Wagner's Carnival, LLC for operation of a complete carnival at the Logan County Fair Tuesday, August 4, 2020 through Sunday, August 9, 2020. Chairman McBride seconded and the motion carried 2-0.

#### No. <u>2019-46</u>

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE 2019 ASSESSMENT YEAR PAYABLE IN 2020 TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF LOGAN, COLORADO, FOR THE 2020 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Logan has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Logan Government Budget Law, on December 10, 2019 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the general operating purposes (General Fund) is \$8,543,778 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Road and Bridge Fund is \$513,819 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Human Services Fund is \$787,855 and;

**WHEREAS**, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Television Translator Fund is \$51,382 and;

**WHEREAS**, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Capital Expenditures Fund is \$342,546 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for Solid Waste Fund is \$ -0- and;

#### NO. 2019-50

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LOGAN COUNTY, COLORADO, TO EXTEND A PREVIOUSLY ENACTED TAX CREDIT TO REDUCE BUSINESS PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the provisions of Section 39-3-119.5, C.R.S., non-exempt personal property shall be exempt from the levy and collection of property tax if the personal property would otherwise be listed on a single personal property schedule and the actual value of such personal property is seven thousand seven hundred dollars (\$7,700.00) or less; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 8(b) of Section 20 of Article X of the Colorado Constitution, each taxing district in Colorado may enact cumulative uniform exemptions and credits to reduce or end business personal property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the personal property tax is a tax which is levied annually and is in addition to all applicable sales and use taxes collected when any personal property is first utilized in a business; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs and the paperwork associated with the preparation and filing of personal property tax schedules by individual business owners, as required by Sections 39-5-107 through -120, C.R.S., are burdensome; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Logan County believes that extending a previously implemented business personal property tax credit would benefit the businesses in Logan County, would not significantly impact the County's budgets and would not cause a reduction in services to taxpayers and residents of Logan County.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Logan County, Colorado, to extend a previously enacted business personal property tax credit for the actual value of business personal property in excess of Seven Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$7,700.00) up to a maximum of Twenty Three Thousand Dollars (\$23,000.00) in actual value of personal property listed on a single personal property schedule. This tax credit shall apply only to business personal property that is the subject of the exemption described in Section 39-3-119.5, C.R.S., and shall apply to all businesses located in Logan County for those taxes to be levied by the Board of County Commissioners of Logan County for the Logan County Budget for tax year 2019, to be collected in 2020, and continuing uninterrupted in all subsequent tax years until further action of the Board.
