**Frenchman Groundwater Property Owners Have 2 Ballots This Election**

The office of the Logan County Clerk and Recorder would like to remind voters that ballots were mailed Monday, October 17, and individual property owners within the Frenchman Groundwater Management District who are active registered voters in Colorado will receive both a regular ballot and a property owner ballot for this election.

If the property is registered to a trust or business the owners will not get a property owner ballot, the property must be owned by an individual. Colorado Revised Statutes Title 37 list taxpaying electors in a groundwater district to be property owners that are registered to vote in the State of Colorado. The property owner ballot is sent ONLY to landowners in that district.

Voters must place the property owner ballot in the property owner return envelope (blue) with an orange sticker (stating property owner on the sticker), and the state ballot needs to be put in the regular return envelope (red). Both envelopes must be signed and returned to the Clerk's office by 7 p.m. on Tuesday, November 8. Voters are reminded that surrounding counties also have property owner ballots, and if you receive one of these, please be sure to return it to the appropriate county.
