There being no further business to come before the Board, the meeting adjourned, at 9:52 a.m.

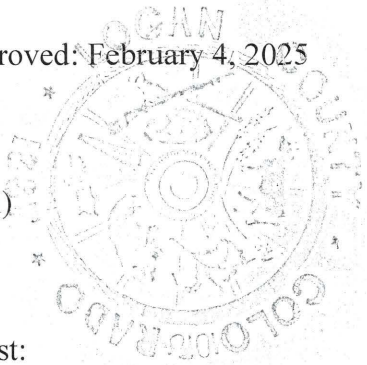


