RESOLUTION

NO. <u>2021 -1</u>

A Resolution Temporarily Waiving County Liquor License Application Fees Co-Extensive With The Waiver Of State Liquor License Fees Authorized By Senate Bill 20B-001.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners is the local liquor licensing authority for business establishments that serve alcoholic beverages in the unincorporated areas of Logan County; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 20B-001 was signed into law on December 7, 2020, which provides, among other things, for a temporary waiver of the state licensing fees, from December 7, 2020 until December 7, 2021, applicable to certain liquor license applications; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 20B-001 was adopted in response to the COVID 19 pandemic and the ongoing public health emergency in Colorado as a means to provide economic relief to small businesses that are subject to mandatory capacity restrictions and have suffered severe declines in revenue due to the pandemic; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the economic losses suffered by local businesses, the Board of County Commissioners deems it in the best interests of Logan County to temporarily waive the local liquor licensing fees co-extensive with the waiver of the state liquor licensing fees as provided in Senate Bill 20B-001.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That County liquor license application fees shall be waived for applications received on or after December 7, 2020, until December 7, 2021.

2. Consistent with Senate Bill 20B-001, the waiver of application fees shall apply to the issuance of new licenses and renewal licenses, but not applications to transfer existing licenses, and shall apply only to the license types specified in Senate Bill 20B-001.

3. Each licensee is only eligible for one waiver in the twelve month period between December 7, 2020 and December 7, 2021. No waiver is authorized for licenses with a "due date" after December 7, 2021.
