



AGREEMENT TO USE LOGAN COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY
INDIVIDUAL PERMIT

THIS AGREEMENT made this (County fills in) 18 day of June, 2024, by and between the County of Logan, State of Colorado, hereinafter called "County", and PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY OF COLORADO/SITE WISE the undersigned easement holder or landowner, hereinafter called "Applicant".

WHEREAS, Applicant owns the following described premises, or has an easement on, over or through said premises, to-wit (legal description): 17045 COUNTY RD 20.5, ATWOOD

_____ ; and

WHEREAS, Applicant desires to install and construct a 1 POTHOLE TO INSTALL 1 ANODE, which will be located **(Circle One):** along bore under, or trench across COUNTY RD 20.5, to benefit the above described premises; and **(pothole to install anodes on gas main)**

WHEREAS, the County is willing to allow such installation and construction by Applicant, but only upon the terms and covenants contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of paying the County the sum of **\$100.00** or **\$200.00** and keeping of the terms and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- Applicant agrees to furnish the County in writing in advance of installation the exact location and dimensions of said installation and construction.
- Buried installations must be at no less than 48 inches below the lowest level of any borrow ditch paralleling the County Road and an "Individual permit" must be submitted for each instance.
- Applicant shall have the right to install and construct 1 POTHOLE TO INSTALL 1 ANODE, described above, in the right of way of COUNTY RD 20.5, but such installation and construction shall be done only in the following manner. All work within the county ROW shall be performed only during regular business hours of the Logan County Road & Bridge Department to enable supervision and inspection of the work.
- All work authorized by this Agreement **shall be completed no later than** 6.14.2024.
- It is understood that no paved or oil-surfaced road shall be cut and will be crossed by boring only. For other roads and crossings of County property after installation. Applicant shall restore the surface to the same condition as existed prior to such construction.
- All cost and expense of installation, construction, maintenance, removal, or replacement is to be paid by the Applicant.
- The traveling public must be protected during this installation with proper warning signs or signals both day and night. Warning signs and signals shall be installed by and at the expense of Applicant.

Applicant hereby releases the County from any liability for damages caused by said 1 POTHOLE TO INSTALL 1 ANODE _____, whether caused by employees or equipment of the County, or others, at any time. Further, Applicant agrees to protect, save and hold harmless, and indemnify the County from and against all liability, loss, damages, personal injuries or expenses suffered by or imposed against the County by reason of the construction, installation or maintenance of the above described improvement.

No perpetual easement or right of way is granted by this instrument and should Applicant's use of said right-of-way interfere with the County's use, or intended use of said right-of-way, Applicant will remove or relocate the same upon demand of the County. Applicant shall pay all costs of such removal or relocation.

This Agreement shall be a covenant running with the above-described real property and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors, personal representatives, and assigns.
