

#### AGREEMENT TO USE LOGAN COUNTY RIGHT OF WAY INDIVIDUAL PERMIT

THIS AGREEMENT made this (County fills in) day of by and between the called "County". Logan, State of Colorado, hereinafter and County of Andrew the undersigned easement holder or landowner, hereinafter called limmerman "Applicant".

WHEREAS, Applicant owns the following described premises, or has an easement on, over or through said premises, to-wit (legal description): <u>New electrical line</u>

section 8 Township 753 ; and

WHEREAS, Applicant desires to install and construct a \_\_\_\_\_\_, which will be located (Circle One): along, bore under, or trench across \_\_\_\_\_\_, to benefit the above described premises; and

WHEREAS, the County is willing to allow such installation and construction by Applicant, but only upon the terms and covenants contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of paying the County the sum of \$100.00 or \$200.00 and keeping of the terms and covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

Applicant agrees to furnish the County in writing in advance of installation the exact location and dimensions of said installation and construction.

Buried installations must be at no less than 48 inches below the lowest level of any borrow ditch paralleling the County Road and an "Individual permit" must be submitted for each instance.

Applicant shall have the right to install and construct  $\underbrace{\text{electrical Service}}_{\text{above, in the right of way of CR 29}}$ , but such installation and construction shall be done only in the following manner. All work within the county ROW shall be performed only during regular business hours of the Logan County Road & Bridge Department to enable supervision and inspection of the work.

All work authorized by this Agreement shall be completed no later than  $\underline{June 30, 2021}$ .

It is understood that no paved or oil-surfaced road shall be cut and will be crossed by boring only. For other roads and crossings of County property after installation. Applicant shall restore the surface to the same condition as existed prior to such construction.

All cost and expense of installation, construction, maintenance, removal, or replacement is to be paid by the Applicant.

The traveling public must be protected during this installation with proper warning signs or signals both day and night. Warning signs and signals shall be installed by and at the expense of Applicant.

- Applicant hereby releases the County from any liability for damages caused by said <u>new electrical line</u>, whether caused by employees or equipment of the County, or others, at any time. Further, Applicant agrees to protect, save and hold harmless, and indemnify the County from and against all liability, loss, damages, personal injuries or expenses suffered by or imposed against the County by reason of the construction, installation or maintenance of the above described improvement.
- No perpetual easement or right of way is granted by this instrument and should Applicant's use of said right-of-way interfere with the County's use, or intended use of said right-of-way, Applicant will remove or relocate the same upon demand of the County. Applicant shall pay all costs of such removal or relocation.
- This Agreement shall be a covenant running with the above-described real property and shall be binding upon the parties hereto, their heirs, successors, personal representatives, and assigns.



PAYMENT All deposits stated herein must be sent by January 1st, 2020 in the form of a cashiers/business check to Braydon Zink and be made payable to Braydon Zink.

All day of show payments must be made immediately prior to following first performance in the form of eash-or eashier's county check to ARTIST unless otherwise agreed upon in advance.

Earned percentages, overages and/or bonuses, if applicable, are to be paid to ARTIST in CASH ONLY immediately following the show. When the ARTIST is to be paid based upon a percentage and/or expenses are factored into the wage agreed, the PURCHASER shall provide:

A. Printer's manifest and a box office statement signed by PURCHASER

B. PRODUCER's representative shall have access to box office at all times during performance N/A C. -A-final-accounting of all-gate receipts

\*\*\*All shall be presented in an organized manner upon final settlement with ARTIST or ARTIST's representative. TICKET PRICE/VENUE CAPACITY — PURCHASER shall not raise the ticket price or increase the venue capacity as set forth in section below. If ticket price or venue capacity increases, 100% of excess revenue generated from the unauthorized increase will be paid in full to ARTIST in cash immediately upon the completion of the performance. If the ticket price or capacity is lower than stated on the face of this contract, PURCHASER shall make up the difference and the difference shall be paid in cash in full upon completion of show.

CANCELLATION—Unless otherwise stipulated to in writing, PURCHASER agrees that ARTIST may cancel the engagement hereunder without liability by giving the PURCHASER at least (30) days notice prior to the day of show. ARTIST shall also have the right to terminate this agreement without liability in the event PURCHASER fails to sign and return this Contract within 14 days of issue date of Contract. NO CANCELLATION PRIVILEGES BY EITHER PARTY

FORCE MAJEURE – In the event that either Artist or Purchaser is unable or prevented from performance due to serious illness, accidents or accidents to means of transportation, civil tumult, strike, riots, epidemics, pandemics, contagion (including but not limited to the ongoing COVID-19 contagion), war conditions or similar circumstances, acts of God, orders of any governmental authority, or any other legitimate condition beyond their control, it is understood and agreed that this agreement shall terminate and each party shall be excused from its obligations under this agreement and shall have no claim for damages or other compensation against the other party by reason of the termination of this agreement, and any deposit paid by Purchaser to Artist shall be refunded to PURCHASER in full.

INSURANCE/INDEMNITY – PURCHASER shall provide, at its sole cost, Commercial General Liability Insurance covering any claims, liabilities, or losses directly or indirectly resulting from injuries to any person (including bodily and personal injury) and from any property damage and/or loss in connection with the Engagement. Such insurance shall be in the amount required by the venue but shall not be less than \$1,000,000
