List of acceptable ID's

Reminder: In order for an identification to be considered acceptable, the address on the ID must be in the state of Colorado.

These are sampling ID's for informational purposes only. Actual identifications may vary.

- A valid Colorado Driver's License.
- A valid Colorado I.D. card issued by the Department of Revenue.



A valid U.S. passport.



 A valid employee I.D. card with a photo of the eligible elector issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government or of Colorado, or by any county, municipality, board, authority, or other political subdivision of Colorado.




 A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other authorized agency of the United States.




- A valid U.S. military I.D. card with a photo. (This is the only form of I.D. that may have an out of state address.)
- A copy of a current utility bill or bank statement, cable bill or telephone bill.
 Documentation from a public institution of higher ED containing at least the name,
 DOB and address of student.

- A paycheck from a government institution or private company or a Certificate of Degree of Indian or Alaskan Native.
- A valid Medicare or Medicaid card.










 A certified copy of a U.S. birth certificate, issued by a state's Vital Records department with a raised seal.



 A certified documentation of naturalization.



- A valid Veteran Identification card issued by the United States
 Department of veterans' affairs veterans' health administration with
 a photograph of the eligible elector.
- A valid student identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by an institute of higher education in Colorado, as defined in section 23-3.1-102(5) C.R.S.
- A valid identification card issued by a Federally recognized Tribal Government certifying tribal membership.

What is NOT acceptable as ID

- Any of the items listed above with an address NOT in the state of Colorado.
- A social security number or social security card.
