The Board opened a public hearing to consider the approval of an application submitted by the Logan County Chamber of Commerce for a Special Events Liquor License for the Cinco de Mayo event to be held at the Logan County Courthouse Square, 315 Main Street, Sterling, Colorado on May 4, 2024.
