Logan County Severe Weather June 2023

Sterling, CO – A heavy rain event in Logan County on Wednesday, June 21 has caused significant flooding in the unincorporated town of Atwood due to overflowing of the Pawnee Creek. A sandbag fill site is set up in the area of Highway 63 and I-76, across from the Atwood Sinclair. Sand and sandbags are available to be filled by residents as needed.

The Sterling Fire Department assisted in the evacuation of the residents of one home in Atwood, including five people, four dogs, three cats and one bird.

Logan County residents who experience damage to their property as a result of this storm are asked to contact Logan County Office of Emergency Management with their address and situation so that the damage can be assessed.
