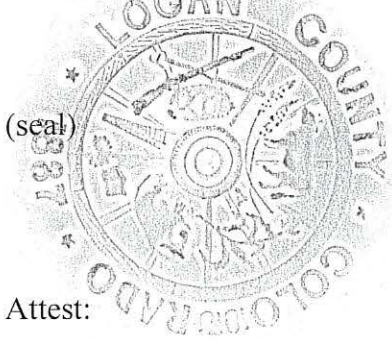
The next regular meeting will be scheduled for Tuesday, October 21, 2025, at 9:30 a.m. at the Logan County Courthouse.
