Precinct 1 Electors that Voted in General 2022 = 658 / Active Voters Registered=1065
Precinct 2 Electors that voted in General 2022 = 558 / Active Voters Registered=913
Precinct 3 Electors that voted in General 2022 = 345 / Active Voters Registered=608
Precinct 4 Electors that voted in General 2022 = 504 / Active Voters Registered=1006
Precinct 5 Electors that Voted in General 2022 = 419 / Active Voters Registered=784

Precinct 12 is the Peetz area,
Precinct 13 is the Iliff area,
Precinct 14 is the Crook area,
Precinct 15 is the Fleming area,
Precinct 16 is Fleming/Leroy area.
