The ballot you receive in the mail is your official ballot and the ballot you need to vote and return to our office for processing. Ballots are mailed to all Active Eligible Voters. As soon as you receive your ballot you may vote the ballot with your choices; sign the return envelope and return it to the Clerk & Recorder's Office.

All voted ballots and replacement ballots must be returned to the Logan County Clerk and Recorder's Office, 315 Main St. Suite 3, Sterling, CO 80751 by 7:00 p.m. June 25, 2024.

- Return your voted ballot via mail before June 18 with proper postage to allow enough time for the post office to deliver to our office. (POSTMARKS DO NOT COUNT) or
- <u>Use our 24/7 Drive up Drop Box located on the southeast side of the Courthouse Parking Lot (postage not necessary).</u>
- Drop your ballot off at the Logan County Clerk & Recorder's Office at 315 Main Street, Sterling, CO 80751, located on the first floor, northwest corner of the Courthouse.

REMEMBER: Logan County Drop Box can be used for Voted Ballots, Motor Vehicle Renewals or Tax Payments or any other correspondence that needs to get to a county office at the Courthouse.
