**When will I receive my ballot?** Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible voters October 11-18, 2024.

**When can I return my ballot?** As soon as you receive your ballot you may return it the following ways:

1. Drop your ballot off at the Logan County Clerk & Recorder's Office at 315 Main Street, Sterling, CO 80751, located on the first floor, northwest corner of the Courthouse or,
2. Drop your ballot in the 24/7 Drive Up Drop Box located in the Courthouse parking lot (Ash Street entrance) east side of the parking area (no postage necessary).
3. Place **adequate postage** on your ballot return envelope and mail it back. **Remember** to allow enough time for mail delivery of your voted ballot. **All ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder's office by Election Day, November 5, 2024, by 7:00 p.m. in order to be counted.**

**IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2024 GENERAL ELECTION:**

- **October 11 – 18, 2024: Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible electors.**
- **October 15, 2024, Tuesday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive. (no later than 22 days before the election)**
- **October 28, 2024, Monday: Last day to submit a voter registration application and still receive a ballot in the mail (Through eight days before the election).**
- **October 28, 2024, Monday – November 5, 2024, Tuesday: Voters can register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot or drop off their mail in ballots in person at the Logan County Clerk & Recorder’s Office 315 Main Street, Suite 3, Sterling, CO 80751**
- **The Logan County Clerk and Recorder’s Office Election Department will be open on Saturday, November 2, 2024, from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. for ballot drop off, replacement ballots.**
- **November 5, 2024: ELECTION DAY**
