ELECTION INFORMATION:

Coordinated Election coming up November 4, 2025.

Our office is asking voters to **MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE! HELP US HELP YOU!**

MAKE A PLAN TO VOTE!

1. **Check your voting information** at www.govotecolorado.gov or contact our office at 970-522-1544 or 315 Main St. Suite 3, Sterling, CO 80751

2. **Have you moved or changed your name due to marriage or divorce?** Change your information at www.govotecolorado.gov

3. **Going to be out of town election day for an appointment or work?** Turn your ballot in before you leave town or contact us so you can vote before you leave.

4. **Have a relative going to college or the military?** Have them add their college or military address as a mailing address to have their ballot sent to them at college or the military.

5. **Reminder ballots are not forwardable.** If your address is wrong the ballot will come back to our office as undeliverable and the USPS will not forward ballots.

- It is very important to have the correct address not just so you get your ballot in the mail BUT so you are voting on the correct information you are supposed to be voting on based on where you live.

EXAMPLE: My voting record address is in the City of Sterling, but I have moved outside the city; I need a ballot without the city of sterling question as I am not eligible to vote for city questions if I live outside the city.

You can vote your ballot immediately and return it to our office, don't have to wait until election day:

- 24/7 Drive up drop box no postage needed- Southeast corner of the Court House parking lot.
- at the Clerk and Recorder's office at 315 Main Street, Suite 3
- Via mail with proper postage before October 27th

ALL BALLOTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY 7:00 PM November 4, 2025, Election Day to be counted.
Turning ballots in early helps our office with getting results out on election day to the public after 7:00 P.M.

BALLOTS WILL BE MAILED OUT OCTOBER 10 – 17. WATCH FOR YOUR BALLOT IN THE MAIL.

- If you don't get a ballot in the mail by October 24th stop by our office and pick up a ballot
- Call our office to get a replacement ballot mailed to you prior to October 27th.
- OR bring valid ID to our office and vote in person starting October 27-November 4.

BallotTrax is a free service for Logan County Voters that allows you to track the status of your ballot online, as well as receive messages by text, phone or email when your ballot has been sent to you and received by our Elections Division. Logan County voters may sign up at votelogancounty.ballottrax.net
