The plate will also include a tagline to read "Feeding the Word". Plate was submitted by or developed with the Logan County Cattlewomen.



- o <u>Who Qualifies:</u> May be issued to any motorcycle, passenger car, truck or non-commercial or recreational motor vehicles that do not exceed sixteen thousand pounds empty weight.
- o Requirements: None
- o <u>Cost:</u> Pay all the regular registration taxes and fees + one-time fee of \$50.00
- o Can be personalized:

- Requirements: This plate requires a \$25 donation to El Movimiento Sigue and the organization will provide them with a PIN to order the plate.
