MOTOR VEHICLE INFORMATION:

License Plate FAQ's

First-Time Vehicle Registration:

Customers who recently purchased a vehicle through a Colorado dealership and have received the "title complete notice" postcard in mail, can complete their first-time vehicle registration online through myDMV in the Vehicle Services tab. If you purchased your vehicle in a private sale from a third party, you will need to visit Logan County Motor Vehicle Office to change the title and plate the vehicle.

Replace License Plates:

Customers who would like to replace their current license plate, to include a personalized plate, can do so through the "Replace License Plate" option through myDMV in the Vehicle Services tab.

NOTE: Please note: Not all plates are available online and some may have to be ordered through the owner's Motor Vehicle Office: especially those that require physical documentation to obtain that plate.

Dealer registered plates:

If you registered your vehicle through a dealership, your plates will be mailed to you via USPS; it can take anywhere from 2-6 weeks for them to be delivered. You can request a secondary temporary permit from the dealership or (obtain one at the county motor vehicle office) if necessary.

How long does it take for my plates to arrive in the mail?

Once ordered online, or through the county, license plates are generally printed and mailed 3 business days after payment is received. Once mailed through USPS, it can take anywhere from 2-6 weeks for them to be delivered.

What if my temporary permit will expire before my plate arrives in the mail?

If your temporary tag will expire prior your plates arriving in the mail, you can visit Logan County Motor Vehicle Office and obtain another temporary permit.

Are license plates tracked when mailed?

Unfortunately, USPS does not provide tracking information on license plates.
