When will I receive my ballot? Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible voters October 16-20, 2023.

When can I return my ballot? As soon as you receive your ballot you may return it the following ways:

- 1. Drop your ballot off at the Logan County Clerk & Recorder's Office at 315 Main Street, Sterling, CO 80751, located on the first floor, northwest corner of the Courthouse or,
- 2. Drop your ballot in the 24/7 Drive Up Drop Box located in the Courthouse parking lot (Ash Street entrance) east side of the parking area (no postage necessary).
- 3. Place <u>adequate postage</u> on your ballot return envelope and mail it back. <u>Remember</u> to allow enough time for mail delivery of your voted ballot. <u>All ballots must be returned to the Clerk and Recorder's office by Election Day, November 7, 2023, by 7:00 p.m. in order to be counted.</u>

IMPORTANT DATES FOR 2023 COORDINATED ELECTION:

- October 16 20, 2023: Ballots will be mailed to all active eligible electors.
- October 16, 2023, Monday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through a voter registration drive. (no later than 22 days before the election)
- October 30, 2023, Monday: Last day to submit an application to register to vote through the mail, a voter registration agency, a local driver's license examination facility, or online to receive a ballot in the mail for the Coordinated Election. (Through the 8th day prior to the election)
- October 30, 2023, Monday: Last day to file an absentee ballot application to receive the absentee ballot by mail if you are absent from your home address.
- October 30, 2023, Monday November 7, 2023, Tuesday: Voters can register to vote, obtain a replacement ballot or drop off their mail in ballots in person at the Logan County Clerk & Recorder's Office, 315 Main Street, Suite 3, Sterling, CO 80751
- <u>Logan County Clerk and Recorder's Office Election Department</u> will be open on Saturday, November 4, 2023, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. for ballot drop off, replacement ballots.
